



WCFW Harvest 4x50 Skeet Shoot

Event: 200 (4x50) targets, Honors only, 12ga, 20ga, 28ga, and .410 bore registered skeet targets. 4 gun shooters have priority. Single gun shooters will be allowed based on availability.

Entry Fee: \$80 includes all fees (NSSA, CSSA, MySkeet) and lunch!

Entry fee payments can be made by cash or check to the Club (WCFW) and given to the onsite shoot manager.

Registration: RESERVATIONS must be made through the MySkeet application. The reservation window will close at midnight September 19th.

THERE WILL BE NO ONSITE SHOOT / DAY OF RESERVATIONS.

Rotation 1 28ga & .410	Field 2 12:20 pm	Field 1 12:20 pm
Rotation 2** 28ga & .410	Field 2 2:00 pm	Field 1 2:00 pm

** Will only add 2nd rotation *after* 1st fills up. If 2nd rotation is not required, the 28ga & .410 will go out at 12:00pm, after lunch.

Referees: This is a “Honors Only” tournament, all squads will be self-pull and self-score. Targets will count towards Colorado State and All-American points / minimums.

Scores: Shoot scores will be posted on the MySkeet online scoreboard. Upon completion of your event the squad leader should check scores and initial the scoresheet before it leaves the field. All score sheets should be immediately turned into the onsite shoot manager who will forward the scores to MySkeet for posting. Shoot-offs, if needed, will be held ½ hour after final scores are turned in.
