Classes (AAA-AA) A, B, C, (D-E)

\$30.00 will be added to 1st in class for each of 12 & 20 Ga. events and will not be subject to the usual splits as above (Gun Champ & RU will receive more than Class Champ)

Champ-of-Champs will be the only option allowed for one day Tournaments. C of C class will be the same as the HOA class

HOA - \$20.00

(Mandatory for all two gun shooters)

(All HOA fees returned to shooters)

\$6.00 Per entry to HOA Champ

\$4.00 per entry to HOA Runner-Up

\$10.00 per entry back to Class

NSSA Scores

Scores will be submitted to NSSA on each 100 targets shot in each gauge and HOA. Ties will be shot-off for event and class champions. Second and third places will be determined by long runs.

Concurrent Events (no fees)

Events 1-3: Honors Only. Champion – Runner-Up and 1-1. Winners will be determined by long runs. Front – back long run ties will be shot off

Shooter Classification

NSSA rules will be followed. It is the shooter's responsibility to ensure that their classification is accurate at registration. Each shooter will receive a printout of their class and events entered at registration. Changes or errors must be brought to the attention of shoot management at the time of registration. Improperly classified registrants forfeit all awards. HOA Classification will be the higher class of your 12ga or 20ga.

Shoot information

Practice fields will be available and ammo can be purchased at the club. Kern County Gun Club reserves the right to modify this program without recourse or protest. Notices of any changes will be posted. The shoot scoreboard is for shooter's information only. Official scores and winners will be maintained on the shoot computer. A protest Committee will be appointed and NSSA protest rules apply. Participants and spectators recognize the exposure to potential injury associated with shotgun sports and assume all risks of accidents and/or injury while attending this event. Ear and eye protection is mandatory for all shooters, field crew and suggested for others.

Shoot-Off Policy

All shoot-offs, unless otherwise noted, will be doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5 miss and out by station. Shoot-offs will be announced with no less than a five-minute call. Any shooter missing his or her shoot-off is considered a "No Show" and forfeits any winnings.

Shooting Times

Each squad is limited to 1 hour and 30 minutes. Please be at the designated field 15 minutes prior to your scheduled shoot time. Squads are encouraged to start early if possible.
